The AML will have four teams guaranteed to participate in the tournament. The KSAC will have two teams guaranteed to participate in the tournament. Two teams will be selected as “at large” qualifiers.

Selection process for #1 and #2 teams:

Top “A” AML team (based on league championship game or on league games (nine league games))

Top “A” KSAC team (based on league games (nine league games))

Seeding process for #1 and #2 seeds:

Winning percentage – total number of games played divided into the total number of games won.

Selection process for #3, #4 #5, #6, #7 and #8 teams:

Second “A” AML team - based on highest winning percentage of league games (nine league games)

Second “A” KSAC team – based on highest winning percentage of league games (nine league games)

Third “A” AML team - based on highest winning percentage of league games (nine league games)

Fourth “A” AML team - based on highest winning percentage of league games (nine league games)

Two teams will enter the tournament as “at large teams” based on:

Winning percentage – total number of games played divided into the total number of games won.

Saturday, Nov. 8 - #3 seed vs. #6 seed at the higher seed
Saturday, Nov. 8 - #4 seed vs. #5 seed at the higher seed

Semi-final games:

Friday or Saturday - Nov. 14 or Nov. 15 - #1-#8 winner vs. #4-#5 winner
(at neutral site)
Friday or Saturday - Nov. 14 or Nov. 15 - #2-#7 winner vs. #3-#5 winner
(at neutral site)

Championship game:

Friday or Saturday - Nov. 21 or 22 - #1-#8-#4-#5 winner vs. #2-#7-#3-#5
winner (at neutral site)

Notes:

Only games scheduled prior to the first practice date of the 2008 – 2009 season will be considered to enter, qualify, and seed the 2008 tournament.

If a school does not play a game, or does not play a number of games, or does not complete the season (due to work stoppage, not enough players, etc.), the game or games not played will be considered a forfeit win for their opponent. The results of games played prior to the team not playing will stand.

If a school has a home site for a game and the school's field is unplayable, the District 9 football committee will pick the site where the game will be played.

If a school has a home site for a game and the school chooses not to host the game, the District 9 football committee will pick the site where the game will be played.

If Port Allegany High School or Sheffield Area High School qualifies for a home game, the game must be played in the daylight. Neither school has lights.

Schools must declare their intention to enter the tournament before or immediately after they play on October 31 or November 1.
