The tournament will be held on Monday, September 25 at the Pinecrest Country Club, at 9:30 a.m. A lunch will be available for players and coaches for purchase. Schools are expected to make payment at the conclusion of the day.

On Saturday, September 30, the top 16 golfers and ties will play an additional 18 holes to determine the 8 western regional qualifiers. The 8 qualifiers will represent District IX at the western regional qualifying tournament on Monday, October 16 at Toms Run Country Club. From the western regional, 22 boys will advance to the state tournament in York on October 23-24

The low composite scores of the 3 players will determine a team champion. The District IX team champion will advance to the western regional qualifying tournament on October 16. The team champion will be able to add a 4<sup>th</sup> golfer to compete at the regional level. From the western regional, 2 teams will advance to the state tournament in York on October 23-24.

The PIAA has requested that each District Golf Tournament use markers and marshals. All coaches will serve as stroke counters, markers, or marshals. The Tournament Director may assign coaches additional duties. To comply with PIAA regulations, caddies are not permitted. Each contestant will carry his own bag.

Schools should list their top three scoring players on their entry form as their school's representatives for the 2006 District IX Team Championship. Additional players may participate if they have a scoring average of 41 for a minimum of 6 varsity competitions. Tri-matches and quad-matches count as a single competition and therefore one score.

All varsity competitions must be counted not the best 6. Additional qualifiers must have a higher qualifying score than the top three qualifiers.

If a school feels that the ability of its players is lacking, they may send fewer than 3 players. The tournament is attempting to qualify the best players to regional and state competitions.

If your school does not have a golf team, but would like to enter individuals, this is permissible. In order to enter an individual, you must assure that a responsible person will accompany the golfer or golfers to the tournament, and be responsible for supervising them during the tournament.

If you are planning such an arrangement, you should contact Tony Flint, District IX Golf Chairman. A statement from the principal indicating who is the designated school representative for the golf championship is required. Individual entries must meet the deadline entry dates listed.

Practice rounds may be arranged by contacting the Pinecrest Country Club. The Pro Shop will assist and arrange a time for you to play the course. Practice rounds can be played during the following times: September 15-anytime, September 16- after 3:30, September 19- after 2 p.m., September 22- anytime, September 23- after 3 p.m., September 24- 9:30-12:30 and after 2:15. Each participant will be permitted one complimentary 18-hole practice round. If a participant wishes to play additional times, they must pay the established green fee rate at the Pennhills Golf Club.
